

Preparation for General Synod

The Convening Circular is posted online at <http://www.anglican.ca/g2010/delegateinfo/> It contains the agenda, the reports and proposed resolutions from the standing committees and councils of General Synod; "Memorials" from dioceses and provinces; and other relevant information. Its sheer volume may be daunting, but it is very important that you take the time necessary to become familiar with the contents. One way to do this is to meet with other members of your diocese before General Synod, if possible. Preparation will enable informed discussion and decision-making at Synod.

You will also need to review the Rules of Order and Procedure found in the Handbook of The General Synod. There will be an opportunity at the orientation session on June 3rd to practice some of the procedures.
