Notes re. 2011 Partnerships budget

- 2011 budget reflects a diminishment of program delivery and a redeployment of funds to initiatives reflecting the role of staff as facilitators of Anglican interest in mission, ecojustice, and healing and reconciliation nationally and globally.
- *3 A leading program priority is truth and reconciliation, specifically the Anglican Church of Canada's participation in the TRC national events. Program funding will continue to be allocated to public engagement initiatives such as Ambassadors for Reconciliation, and or collaborative projects such as "Healing from the Legacy of Residential Schools" workshops co-sponsored with the United Church of Canada for frontline workers (clergy, social workers, etc.). Anti-racism training will continue to be funded. A second priority is leadership in the Anglican Communion, specifically the Anglican Church of Canada's participation in Communion networks and partnerships with selected Anglican Provinces and/or dioceses. Grants to global partners and ecumenical organizations will be discontinued, with two exceptions: Council of Anglican Provinces of Africa (CAPA), and Episcopal Church in Cuba. 2014 as
- *4 Existing theological education scholarships will be continued but gradually phased out in current scholarship students complete their degrees.

 A partner consultation process in 2010 and 2011 will inform the development of new ways of working in partnership with global Anglican Provinces and networks.
- *5 Two programs -- Volunteers in Mission (VIM) and the Theological Students' International Internship Program -- will be phased out by April 5, 2011. The current Program Coordinator, Jill Cruse, will convene discussions with key stakeholders (Canadian dioceses; Anglican Provincial partners; Canadian Churches' Forum for Global Ministries; ELCIC; and, Canadian theological colleges) of these two programs, and produce recommendations for devolving to dioceses and/or theological colleges and seminaries.
- A component of the Global Relations Program Coordinator's work will be to enable Canadian Anglican relations with . global and Communion partners
- *6 Since a VIM volunteer is currently serving in Guatemala until late 2011, we will budget funds for her re-entry program in early 2012.
- The Coordinator of Ecumenical and Interfaith Advocacy and Government Relations will undertake discussions with key stakeholders

 (Anglicans involved in environmental and national justice work; KAIROS; CCC and others) to develop a strategy to maximize ecumenical and interfaith partner organizational capacity for Anglican commitments in these areas. The work on Justice Camps

will be linked to the General Synod development of the Youth Secretariat.

Explanation re. 2011 funding for three Councils[1], KAIROS and the Canadian Churches' Forum for Global Ministries (CCFGM).

a. On September 16, the Primate, General Secretary, Partnerships Director, and Faith/Worship/Ministry Interim Director met, and proposed that the 2011 commitment to "Councils" (to be renamed "Ecumenical Partners" and to include KAIROS and the Canadian Churches Forum for Global Ministry) of \$317,000 be offset by funds from the Ministry Investment Fund (MIF) following a successful proposal for "transition" funding. It was suggested there be no cut in the grant to the ACC in 2011.

Assuming MIF funding, the 2011 distribution will appear as follows –

The MIF funding is for 1 year only. Plan 2012 to 2015 reflects the full partnership reductions. The challenge in 2011 is to review and recommend how the Anglican Church will meet its commitment to working with ecumenical and interfaith groups.

ASSUMPTIONS (2010)

- *1 Suspension of various grants and reductions Canadian and global partner grants will free up funds to evaluate Partnerships programs, hold a partner roundtable and draft a new Partnerships program strategy.
- *2 In 2010 there is a salary freeze.
- *3 Director travel includes General Synod global partner travel, meal, acc costs = \$4,400 (\$115 x 10 days, \$3000 airfare, \$250 incidentals)
