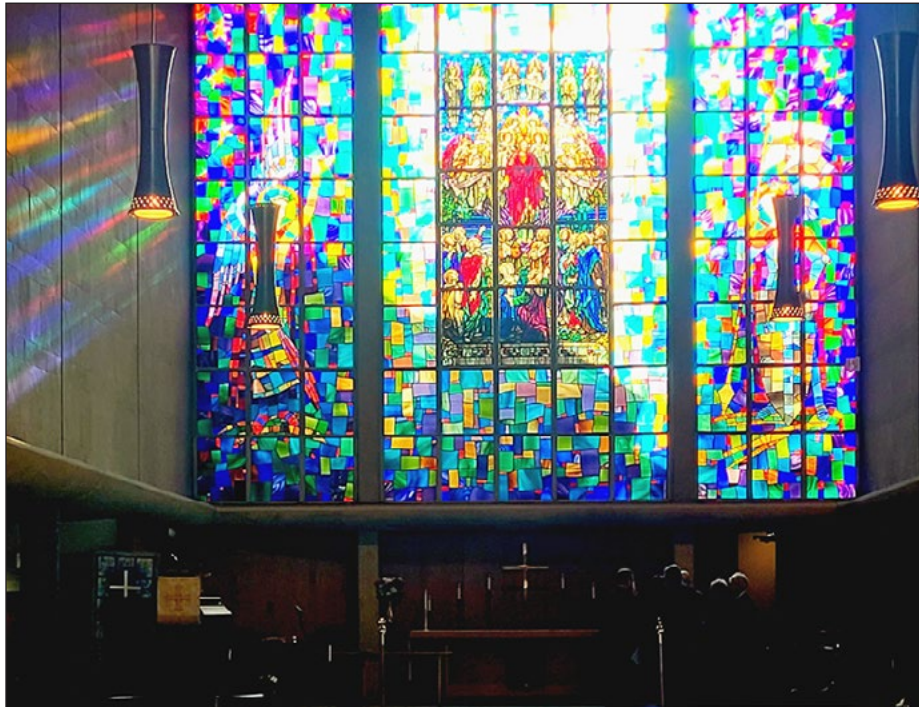

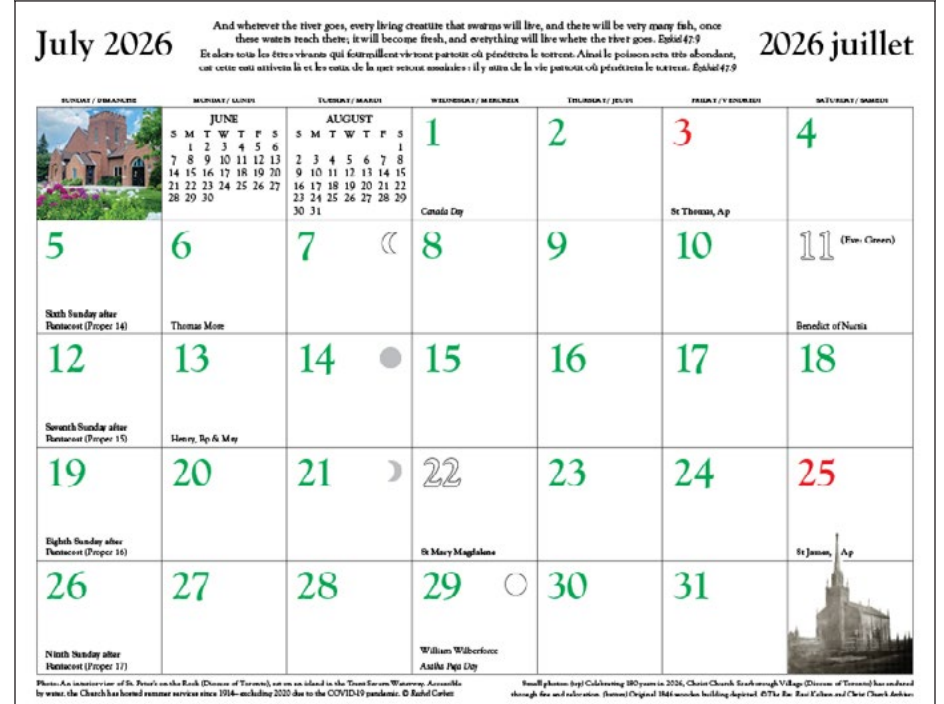

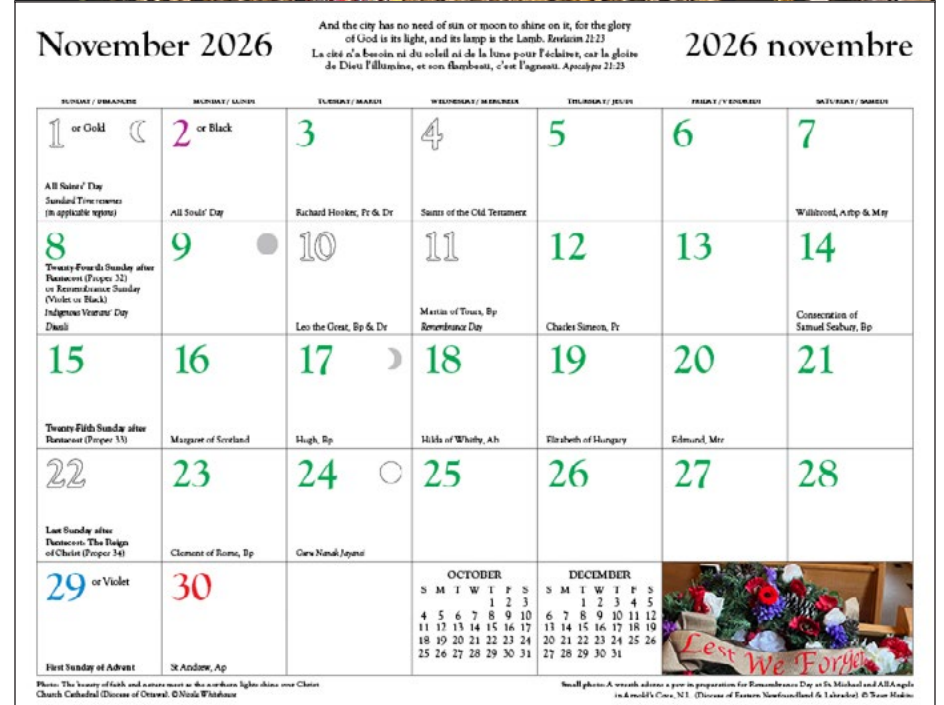

Liturgical Colours in this Calendar

Since at least the 12th century, churches have used a variety of colour schemes for vestments and decorations to mark the liturgical seasons and holy days. The Anglican Church of Canada does not recommend any colour scheme, but the one legislated for use in the Roman Catholic Church in the 16th century (and revised in the 1960s) has become popular among Anglicans everywhere over the last 150 years (white, red, violet, and green). This calendar follows that scheme with the exception that blue, which has become popular in North America over the last fifty years, is offered as an alternative to violet during Advent, an option given for the traditional use of rose for the Advent 3 and Lent 4 and black for Good Friday and All Souls' Day.

The use of colours can assist in distinguishing greater or lesser degrees of celebration among the Holy Days, Memorials, and Commemorations of the Anglican liturgy. In this calendar, in accordance with the rubrics in *The Book of Alternative Services*, Holy Days (indicated in bold type) and Memorials (except during Advent, Lent, and Easter, when they keep the colour of the season) are assigned a special colour for the day. Commemorations retain the colour of the season in which they fall.

The celebration of Sundays and most Holy Days begins the evening of the preceding day. Accordingly, some dates have a bracketed letter indicating the colour of that evening, which forms part of the Sunday or Holy Day that follows. It is now common for certain Principal Feasts to be anticipated on the Sunday before (Epiphany) or transferred to the Sunday following (Ascension and All Saints). The other Principal Feasts (Christmas) are not transferred and Easter, Pentecost, and Trinity Sunday always occur on a Sunday.

Other Observances

This calendar includes the Holy Days, Memorials and Commemorations of the Anglican Church of Canada. Rogation Days may be observed on the three days before Ascension Day or at other times of year when crops are planted and harvested. A Harvest Festival may be held on the national Thanksgiving holiday or according to local agricultural circumstances. Ember Days, traditionally observed on the Wednesday, Friday and Sunday after Advent 3, Lent 1, Pentecost, and Holy Cross Day, may be kept in relation to local ordination arrangements or at other times when it is desired to pray for the whole ministry of the Church. A Feast of Dedication may be held on the anniversary of the consecration of a church or chapel or on the twenty-fourth of October or the Sunday before All Saints' Day. Many parishes observe Remembrance Sunday and Corpus Christi (observed on the Thursday or Sunday after Trinity Sunday).
