Diocesan and Parish Statistics 1968

NOTES

1. The response to the new report forms, supplied to diocesan officers late last year, has provided information more fully than some of us might have expected in the circumstances. Two dioceses, for understandable reasons, were unable to use the new form; Caledonia due to disruption of their office procedures; and Toronto where the information was supplied on the form used in former years. A few dioceses left out some figures or sections, but generally the reporting is entirely useful.
2. This new form of reporting arises chiefly from two factors that were not clear in the former return. The possible significance of the priests "in secular employment" for future planning, led to the belief that we should provide statistical detail on their whereabouts, particularly of those who remain active in a part-time priestly ministry. Also the breakdown of Diocesan and Parishes income and expenditure figures is expected to provide a clearer picture of the categories and their percentages of the source of dollars and their use. It is hoped also, that in having this clearer picture, we will overcome a difficulty in some past reports which showed serious and unexplained discrepancies between total income and total expenditure. This latter factor had proven to be a difficulty when trying to analyse figures in whole or in part.
3. In the tables supplied, the letter "x" following a figure implies that this is taken from reports of last year, as for one reason or another the detail was not given in the recent return. In some cases the detailed breakdown of income or expenditures is not reported consistently by the dioceses. This is due to a difficulty in adapting their own figures to this new form. An example of this is that clergy costs and/or building maintenance costs may not be isolated from parish program figures. This will right itself as we continue to use and become familiar with the form. It will be noticed that some columns are not added because the particular items, if totalled would be misleading if used for analysis. The form for Parishes reporting as supplied to diocesan officers, we hope will be useful, as printed, for distribution to parish officers.
4. The tables provided in this leaflet are to be considered a part of the Report on the State of the Church as given by Bishop Jackson and printed on page 182 of the Journal Proceedings. It is pointed out that in whatever way the General Synod receives the report, it would be useful not to preclude the possibility of making changes in some of the tables before printing in the Journal. It is quite possible that diocesan officers may find errors in the compilation, or have adjustments to offer for clarification of their figures as they relate to the whole. It should be noted also that the final printing in the Journal should contain tables giving comparisons with former years, as has been a useful practice in the past.
