

Our Marriage Canon states quite simply and beautifully that, “*The Church affirms in like manner the goodness of the union of man and woman in marriage, this being the blessing of God’s creation.*” If the Marriage Canon is modified to accommodate same-gender marriage, what sort wording will this statement be replaced with? I do not see biblical evidence to support changing our Marriage Canon to accommodate any sort of wedded union apart from that of one man and one woman to the exclusion of all others.

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
