Canon Dr. Robert Falby, Q. C.

Diocese of Toronto

Canon (lay) Robert L. Falby, QC, chair of the Anglican Church of Canada's Commission on the Marriage Canon and former prolocutor of General Synod died June 8, 2015.

Born in 1941 in the northern Ontario town of Cochrane, Canon Falby did his undergraduate studies at Victoria College, University of Toronto, and graduated from Toronto's Osgoode Hall law school in 1967. He was called to the bar in 1969, and became a Queen's Counsel in 1982.

As a member of the church's residential schools negotiating committee, Canon Falby played a pivotal part in discussions with the federal government that led to the Indian Residential Schools Settlement Agreement of 2006.

When asked if the 1993 apology to Canada's Indigenous peoples—made by then Anglican primate, Archbishop Michael Peers—had created a dangerous legal liability, Falby replied, famously: "Whether it did or not, it was the right thing to do."

In 2002, he was installed as a lay canon of the Cathedral Church of St. James and he received the Anglican Award of Merit in 2004.
